NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ALL DOGS SHOULD BE PRESENT AT LEAST 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO JUDGING. OWNER OR HANDLER IS SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR HAVING THE DOG AT RINGSIDE WHEN IT IS TIME FOR ITS CLASS TO BE JUDGED. WE WILL NOT CALL FOR YOU!

An AKC Fee of \$3.50 (Recording Fee \$0.50, Event Service Fee \$3.00) will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test, and an AKC Fee of \$3.00 for Rally. This fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only (AKC Rule, Chapter 15, section 2). These fees are included in the entry fee for this trial.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian, Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or if because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show. Acts beyond the control of management include extreme heat and hurricanes. Please note that Volusia County Fairgrounds is a hurricane shelter in Volusia County allowing animals and thus might be unavailable to use even without immediate threat of a major hurricane. One half of the entry fee will be refunded upon request to the Trial Secretary for a bitch coming into season after the closing date of entries for this obedience or rally trial. Full refund will be made for bitches that come in season, if written notification is received by the Trial Secretary PRIOR TO ENTRY CLOSE DATE. Due to workload, refunds cannot be made on day of trial; they will be mailed at a later date.

MOVE UPS

(Applies to both Obedience and Rally).

After a dog earns a title, it may be moved up to the next class even though the closing date for the trial has passed. This move-up may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. **The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.** Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level class and the judge is available and the class has not reached its limit. **Please turn in move-up forms as soon after your class ends as possible. No move-ups will be accepted after 7:30 AM on Saturday and 7:00 AM on Sunday.**

For your protection, please be sure all vaccinations are up-to-date. Dogs must be kept on leash unless in the ring.

Trophies must be picked up on the day of trial. None will be mailed. Trophies not picked up become the property of OCOD and will be awarded at a later trial under the same donor. A qualifying score in a regular class is required to win a trophy. If the Highest Scoring Dog is not represented when the trophies are awarded that trophy will not be presented.

ENTRY FEE

Entry Fee will be \$22 for the first entry of a dog in a regular Obedience class; \$12 for the additional entry of the same dog on the same day in another regular Obedience class.

Entry Fee will be \$22 for the first entry of a dog in a regular Rally class; \$12 for the additional entry of the same dog on the same day in another regular Rally class.

No entry will be accepted, canceled or changed after the closing date except as detailed above. Entry fees shall not be accepted without signatures and fees, or unless on an official AKC entry form. Telegraph, telephone, fax, e-mail and UNSIGNED entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC form are not acceptable.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. 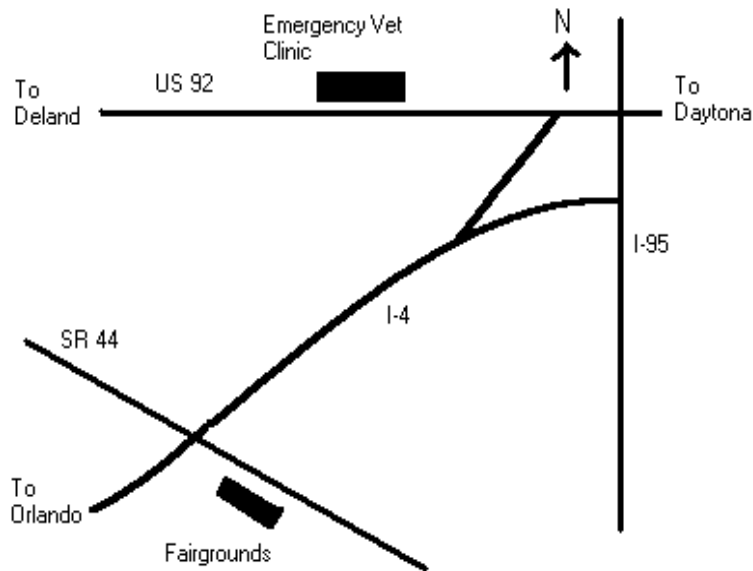
